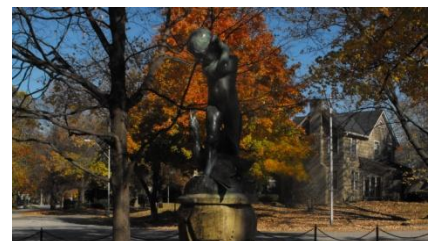

## SAY IT ISN'T SNOW



With our first light dusting of snow this past week and dropping temps we must begin to think about snow removal. Here are some reminders about Armour Hills snow removal to help make the process easy for the neighborhood.

Armour Hills will provide private plowing for snow events in excess of 4 inches again this year. Email notices will be sent out based on local forecasts to allow homeowners time to prepare. Residents are encouraged to share driveways and pull vehicles off the street to allow the plows room to clear each street curb-to-curb. Drive aprons may also need to be shoveled after the plows are finished.
