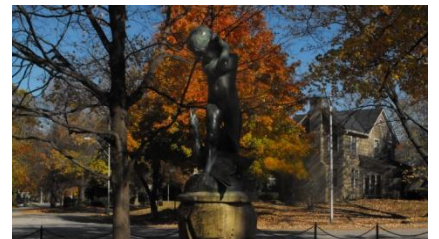

While Kansas City was thinking about the World Series, Armour Hills was thinking about snow removal. Last winter was mild, so here are some reminders about snow removal to help make the process easy for the neighborhood.

Armour Hills will provides private plowing for snow events in excess of 4 inches. Email notices will be sent out based on local forecasts to allow homeowners time to prepare. Residents are encouraged to share driveways and pull vehicles off the street to allow the plows room to clear each street curb-to-curb. Drive aprons may also need to be shoveled after the plows are finished.
